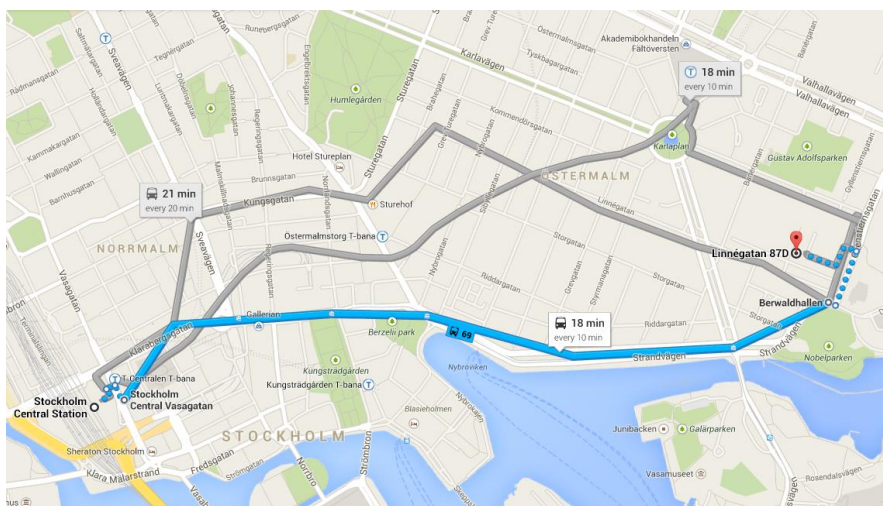

Get off the bus after 15 min at Berwaldhallen. Head east on Strandvägen toward Oxenstiernsgatan. Turn left onto Oxenstiernsgatan, then turn left again onto Linnégatan
