





Aim to achieve highest level of sanitation of hygiene in CHCs ,UCHCs & UPHCs.

Launched SSS guidelines for Rural Area – 2016

• Launched SSS guidelines for Urban Area-2019

 Rs 10 L per CHC & UCHC and 50K for UPHC in each ODF block is given to achieve high level of cleanliness & meet Kayakalp Parameters.

• Till 2021-22 – 3000+ HCF were supported

3 Best PHCs in country awarded by Jal Shakti Ministry in 2018-19 for exemplary performance






Swachhata Pakwada






