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### **GPs- characteristics**



- Not homogenous
  - Size diversity: very small to very large population
  - Population diversity:
  - Constituent geographies: Single village, multi-village
  - Terrain diversity: several types
  - Strengths vary from state to state- need appropriate attention
- Except in few states, they are yet evolving
  - Role clashes: Local Government Vs Development implementation agency
  - Governments devolved functions and part finances to PRIs not functionaries
  - With available workforce, there is a capacity/ competency crisis
