

Kirkpatrick's Four Levels of Evaluation Model

effectiveness of the training programmes

Reaction - 88% - positive perception

• Learning 72% - confident of knowledge & skills

Behaviour 44% - implemented projects

Result- 78%; 33%; 44%; 89%
