

Boodheri Ecosan Program

- Objectives
 - Introduce toilet sanitation
 - Without significant water needs
 - Use of ecosan products
- 54 UDDTs constructed till date
- EcoPro Roles
 - Building
 - Monitoring usage
 - Maintenance audit
 - User education

- Changing a habit and a mindset
- Not just toilet rooms but bathrooms.
- A certain status value.
- Completing nutrient cycles targeting sustainability.

Project main challenges





- People are in favour of open defecation!
- Toilets used only for night visits or on rainy days.
- Lack of awareness for toilet hygiene, organic farming techniques (such as compost use)
- Toilets being used and misused as storage space.
- Most of the urine collected is wasted unused or simply not used purposefully.
- EcoPro required to take lead to empty fecal compost chambers

- Awareness sessions for school students since August 2016.
- Educational movies and documentaries screened for villagers.
- Visits from other villages and hamlets to Boodheri.
- EcoPro wants to recruit farmers from the neighbourhood to enable the application of urine and compost in agriculture.





- 10 out of 48 UDDTs are used regularly and maintained well.
- Earliest adopters Children (5 to 10 years).
- Fecal compost from four households has been collected and used in orchard, rice fields. (Yield/HH= 300kg)
- 16 houses supplied with plastic cans for urine collection. In other households, urine is used directly in the garden or simply drained into the ground.
- Field trial by local paddy farmer willing to use ecosan products.
