



Aspects to be considered when assessing and planning public toilets in slums and tourist locations

Public Toilets in Slums

- 1. Presence of PT in slums is mandatory and function of the individual HH toilet coverage
- 2. The lower the HH toilet coverage higher the need to provide a PT. Toilets provided predominantly temporary in nature since the trend is slums is towards individual toilets. PTs are interim solution.
- 3. Focus on Access to Toilet (e.g. distance and safety), services follows
- 4. Provision of toilets needs to follow norms
- 5. PT that are at a distance of less than 0.5 km, then slum HH users has to be integrated into the toilets operations (financially).

Public toilets for tourists

- 1. Focus on quality of service. One time user
- 2. Cleanliness, privacy, pricing, short waiting time critical
- 3. User fee accepted (compulsion). Tourists are not price sensitive Indian & western toilet required
