

Conference Objectives



- Updating on WinS progress in each participating country & sharing knowledge. The sharing will focus on the WinS Enabling Environment at the national level.
- Sharing Indonesia's progress and plans in incorporating Hand Washing with Soap, Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM) and related WASH infrastructure improvements into national programmes, and describing the linkages to Indonesia's WASH in Schools & Fit for School programmes.
- Cross learning from other countries and identifying possibilities for collaboration.
- Sharing lessons learned and experiences for policy advocacy and improving political commitment for WinS.
- Participating in technical expert sessions on critical issues affecting scale-up of WinS including Monitoring & Evaluation and the SDGs, group handwashing with soap, Menstrual Hygiene Management, Financing, and Operation and Maintenance of WASH facilities in schools.





What you need to know

- Ministry of Education and Culture Building A
 - Ground level : Opening Ceremony and Lunch
 - 2nd Floor : Group discussion (3 rooms)
 - 3nd Floor : Main Hall and VIP room
- Three exit doors at the ground level
 - Front door/Entrance door
 - Back door
 - Side door
- Assembly point : field/open space in front of Building A

In the event of an Emergency

- The emergency focal point will instruct whether you are required to evacuate the building
- Keep calm and do not rush
- Do not use lift
- Go directly to the assembly point
- Wait for further instruction
- Do not re-enter the building until instructed it is safe to do so
