Bangarammapalem GP (Visakhapatnam district)



Four rounds of COVID Surveys conducted to trace people with ill health. Regular inspection & monitoring by ANM, Mahila Police



Village Secretariat functionaries & volunteers take active part in creating awareness for the Dos & Don'ts & COVID Appropriate Behaviour



Creation of Containment Zones, sanitization of the zones & contact tracing of cases



Implementing Manam Mana Pari Shubratha, a social work program for improved sanitation. ₹2/household/day collected for the program & ₹51,750 collected till date



Setting up of fever clinics, immunization & 104 services (bi-weekly) & continuous monitoring of public health

Tinsukia Zilla Parishad



 Distribution of face masks in all 85 GPs. Over 3,000 face masks distributed as on date & sanitization of public places three times a day since 3rd May 2021



Kalbari GP (Barpeta district)

 Ward Level Task Force Committee set up in all the 10 wards to follow-up the guidelines issued for Home quarantined village patients, sanitization of public places, spreading Covid awareness



Sapekhati GP & Naharpukhuri GP (Charaideo district)

 Formation of Home Quarantine Committees, sanitization of public places, creating awareness, supply of ration to economically weaker & Covid affected households





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats of Madhya Pradesh





 Formation of village level teams like GP Sajchav, Rojgar Sahay, Asha Jayanti, etc. to provide assistance to the local administration in the fight against the pandemic



 Aajeevika SHG prepared 2,000 masks during the lockdown; spreading awareness on sanitation and undertaking sanitization by Swachhagrahi Kanshi Ram Varavade

Unao GP (Datia District)



 The GP has been declared Covid free; 483 senior citizens vaccinated till date



 Door-to-door mask distribution, spreading awareness on COVID Appropriate Behaviour, regular sanitization of public places & strict observance of Janata curfew







Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats of Bihar_(1/2)



Bithuna GP (Siwan District)

Distribution of masks to villagers, sanitization of public places, spreading awareness and conducting vaccination drives



Adampur GP (Nalanda District)

Distribution of 6 masks per family (97% families covered so far); spreading awareness, sanitization of public places & conducting vaccination drives



Pator GP (Darbhanga District)

Distributed 13,458 masks covering 96.50% families, spreading awareness, sanitization of public places & conducting vaccination drives (over 60% who are aged over 45 vaccinated)





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats Of Bihar (2/2)





Mask distribution completed in 9 out of 15 wards; spreading awareness & sanitization of public places & conducting vaccination camps (500 out of 3,200 people vaccinated)

Simri GP (Madhubani District)



Setting up of additional PHC as a vaccine center, spreading awareness, sanitization of important sites, distribution of masks to 1,500 out of 2,985 families completed

Govindpur GP (Katihar District)



Masks distributed to 3000/4000 families, regular antigen & RT-PCR test conducted and home quarantining of suspected COVID patients. 15 of the 16 COVID positive patients have recovered





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats of Karnataka





Conduct free registration camp & facilitate vaccination drive; Training of new members by Viral Disease Control Task Force to provide free vehicle & sanitisation services; supply of medical assistance & free food kits to families in need



Hoddur GP (Kodagu District)

Conduct Covid tests to migrants, provides medical kit & food essentials to home quarantined people & undertakes awareness and sanitization activities



GP Munirabad (Koppal District)

Monitoring movement of people, distribution of food packets, medical aid to poor, arranging Covid control equipment and undertaking sanitization activities





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats Of Kerala (1/2)





Mayyil GP (Kannur District)

Local Covid management enforced through volunteers & committees; spreading awareness, helpline & helpdesk numbers floated & conducting covid tests every 3 days wherever rise in cases are reported



Muhamma GP (Alappuzha District)

Home isolation is being implemented; RRT system strengthened & special training imparted to members; monitoring situation everyday; volunteers, helpline numbers & whatsapp groups assigned for each cluster





Transportation facility provided in collaboration Voluntary Organisations such as Sevabharathy, Youth Congress etc.; Oxygen cylinder mounted vehicle made available for needy patients; spreading awareness through social media groups





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats Of Kerala (2/2)





Covid Jagratha Samithi of 30 members formed; also RRT formed with 75 members; Formation of 24 hr Help Desk to overlook activities & Ward level Jagratha Samithi having 20 members in every ward

Azhiyoor GP (Kozhikode District)



'Mask is must' campaign and distribution of masks started; focus on strict enforcement of Covid norms & Night squad for travellers who violate restrictions; Mobile Clinics set up & and special attention given to children & the elderly

Rajakkad GP (Idukki District)



Commercial establishments (except essential ones) closed indefinitely from 11 am to 5 pm since 3rd May; Covid Firstline Treatment Centre set up along with a call center for assistance. 3 Ambulances, 5 Auto rickshaws, and 1 Car engaged free of cost for Covid patients in need





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats of Maharashtra (1/3)

Bhosi GP (Nanded District)



House visits by PR members to mobilise testing & daily tests conducted; all co-morbids & elders given special attention & PHC staff deployed at hotspot areas



Covid patients & their acquaintances quarantined & given medical aid kits; Anti Corona task force working to expand vaccination drive

Hivare Bajar GP (Ahmednagar District)



Helps Covid affected families with day to day activities and continuously monitored the symptoms of patients; used blood tests for diagnosing Covid; banned all social gatherings; planned vaccination of the vulnerable





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats of Maharashtra (2/3)

Bhoyare Khurd (Ahmednagar District)



Teams formed to isolate people having flu-like symptoms without waiting for test reports; wearing of masks made mandatory & banned social gatherings; planned for vaccination of vulnerable groups in the village. The GP has achieved zero active patient

Chandankheda GP (District Chandrapur)



Set up an institutional quarantine in the village; Teams formed to isolate people having flu-like symptoms and conduct RAT/RTPCR Test; wearing of masks made mandatory & banned social gatherings; and strict actions against protocol violators





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats of Maharashtra (3/3)

Khursapar GP (Nagpur District)



Appointment of Covid Yodha in all wards; conducts vaccination & awareness drives; home guards deployed for management of entry points of village; the GP has achieved zero active patient



Installation of CCTV cameras in all main streets and chawk & sanitization machines in public places

Umbarpada Saphale GP (District Palghar)



Setting up Covid Care Centre in School Building & Vaccination Centre in GP premises; facilitated setting up RAT facility in local PHC



Distribution of Medical Kits to affected cases both for symptomatic/asymptomatic cases; disinfection of public premises; encouraging local merchants to carry out mass RT-PCR tests





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats of Nagaland

Six Blocks of Dimapur District



COVID-19 awareness conducted through participatory approach by the concerned block level officers along with the Village Council



Village Level Organizations (with SHG members) trained on handling emergency cases



The Village Councils passed a resolution of adopting Covid protocols for the successful implementation of lockdown



Use of pamphlets, announcement, etc. carried out on a regular basis by Village Authorities



Churches used as a platform to spread awareness on sanitation, hygiene, social distancing & masking



Bamboo technology used for hand washing facilities in villages





Best Practices to Fight COVID-19 by Panchayats of Nagaland

Changsu (New) Village (Wokha District)



Conducted Covid-19 awareness programme during VHND cum RI session; sensitization on vaccine



Conducting vaccination drives; 159 first dose of Covishield and 36 second dose administered so far



Elderly and severe Covid patients are being provided homebased care



Monthly routine Immunization and observance of Village Health Nutrition Day



Activities like 'Fit India Freedom Run", staff picnics, continuous nursing education, observation of World Health day, Nurses day, etc, are being carried out in the HWC
