Important Aspects for Coordination with Partners

- Send official letter to main partners (the competent ministry, construction authorities, etc.) to hold a meeting with them to introduce the project objectives, Project activities and expected results.
- 2) Involve and coordinate with all relevant partners that can enrich the project outputs.
- 3) Formation of the project Steering Committee to provide support, guidance, and oversight of progress.
- 4) Requesting official technical representatives to coordination and communication on behalf of the official authorities and project partners.
- 5) Collect available official data and results of relevant studies and previous developmental processes related to the project objectives and any expected updates that will occur during the project period.
- 6) Preparing a work plan and a schedule of activities that will be implemented and discussing it with the official partners of the project based on the official proposal of the project.
- 7) Conduct regular meetings periodically or as needed to discuss progress (completion percentages) and any new topics related to project activities.
- 8) Agree on a joint monitoring and evaluation system with the official partners to follow up the project activities to make sure the project activities will end within the time frame.
