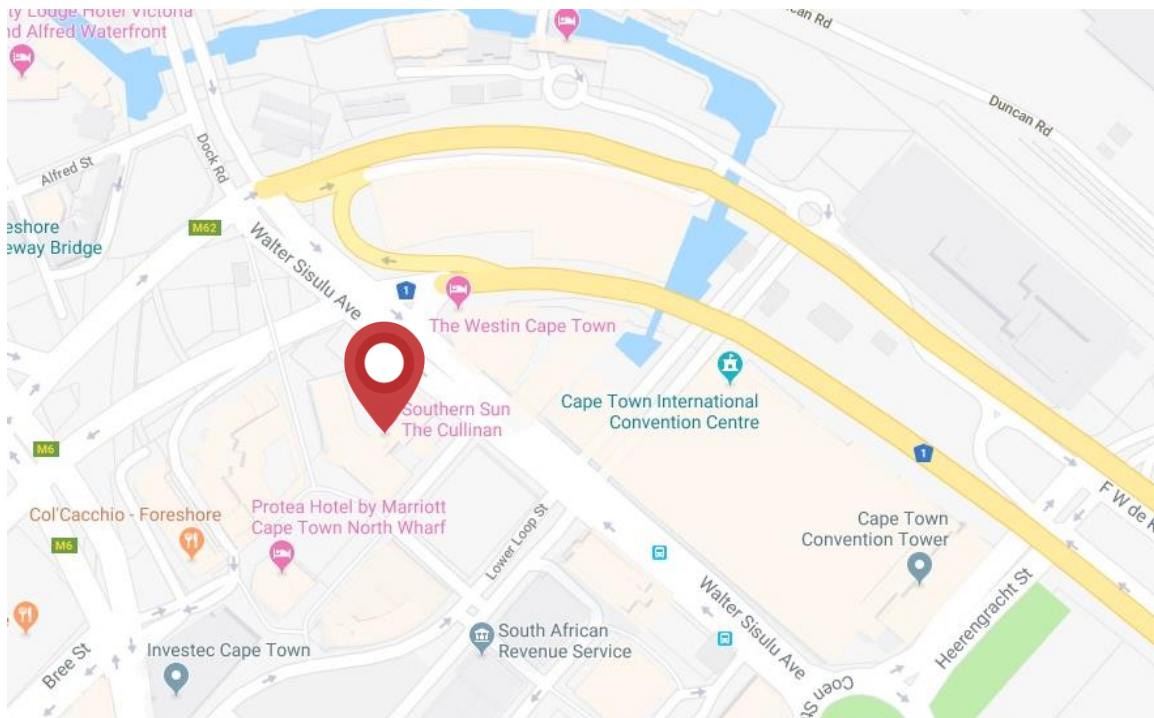

Directions from Southern Sun The Cullinan Hotel to dinner location at Mama Africa, located at 178 Long Street, Cape Town City Centre:

- Head southwest on Cullinan St (toward Wharf St) for about 150 m.
- Turn right onto Lower Loop St and walk for about 140 m.
- Turn left onto Hans Strijdom Ave/M6 and walk for 84 m.
 - Turn right onto Long St and continue for about 1 km – you will see Mama Africa on your right.
